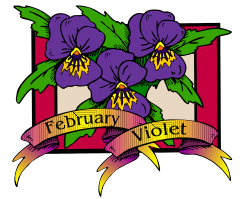

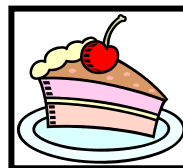

Beulah Association will host a mission trip thru NC Baptist Men to Hazleton, Pennsylvania, July 23-29. During this mission trip you will enjoy mission opportunities like Backyard Bible studies, VBS, community picnic, and light construction. BBA will stay at Hazleton Community Church. Hazleton is centered at the intersection of two major highways that run through the state. It used to be a coal mining town. The mines are closed, but the people never left. They have adjusted with the times, and are creating new jobs for the community. There are approximately 36,000 people living in the city. The religious atmosphere of Hazleton is primarily Roman Catholic.

Hazleton Community Church is a church plant which started in July, 2006. They outgrew the house they were meeting in and rented a room at a local restaurant during the winter of 2006. Since the community associates a church with a building, they began looking for a church building to meet. God provided them a church building that was vacant at the time. God is at work in Hazleton. Will you commit to pray about going to Hazleton this summer? This is a great opportunity for anyone looking to go on a short term mission trip. Come join BBA for an informational meeting.

The large urban centers of the US have become the next great missions frontier because of the enormity of the lostness and the lack of Gospel witness.

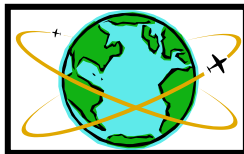
